<p>BREWED ESPECIALLY FOR OUR 10TH FESTIVAL! This is a slightly hazy natural IPA that offers a subtle floral aroma and fruity taste. This ale has been dry hopped with citra and hercules for 7 days giving a smooth drink packed with lovely flavours.</p>					
2.	BANG ON BREWERY	LAZY LOBSTER	PALE ALE	4.4	
<p>BREWED ESPECIALLY FOR OUR 10TH FESTIVAL! A standard pale ale that is fresh and easy to drink. It's designed for people that are not into hoppy beers and want a traditional pale with a beery taste.</p>					
3.	BRAGDY MANTLE	CWRW TEIFI	BEST BITTER	4.5	
<p>All the way from sunny Cardigan this copper coloured best bitter is malt driven, full flavoured and well balanced with British and European Hops.</p>					
4.	GREY TREES	AFGAN ALE	PALE ALE	5.4	
<p>Crafted like an American pale ale, full of Cascade, Citra and Simcoe hops. The Maris Otter malt provides a perfect light colour and dryness to complement the crisp taste and full aroma of the hops.</p>

<p>A refreshing hazy, pale tropical IPA. Enticing mango and passion fruit aromas draw the drinker in to the satisfying full flavours of mango, grapefruit and lime, finishing with lingering zesty tropical fruits.</p>

<p>This ale was in the 1st B&C Fest and isn't your average bitter - the hops do more to this deep amber coloured beer than just provide bite. Some of the most aromatic and tangy hops from the other side of the pond have been used to give this red Ale a fresh hit that complements the caramel flavours of the malts that gives this beer its colour.</p>					
10.	CWRW NANT	BACH O HWNE	BEST BITTER	3.7	
<p>A tasty traditional bitter with caramel notes and slight hoppy fragrance. Nicely bitter finish and almost amber in colour.</p>					
11.	CWRW NANT	AUR Y FELIN	BLONDE IPA	3.4	
<p>A very thin ale with no distinct aroma. Slight sweet biscuit malt and detectable citrus hop in flavour leading to a bitter/dry finish.</p>					
12.	POLLYS	POLLYS FLORET	PALE ALE	4.2	
<p>A pale ale is delicious, hazy juicebomb of a beer, balanced with enough bitterness to keep drinkers coming back for more. positively bursting at the seams with peach, mango, and pineapple notes, backed up with pithy orange peel from its Citra, Simcoe and Azacca hop bill.</p>					
13.	POLLYS	POLLYS LITTLE PETAL	PALE ALE	5.2	
<p>Little Petal takes a detour from our usual output down the Pacific highway for a deliciously moreish West Coast Pale - clean and crisp resinous bitterness takes the lead here, with a classic hop lineup of Cascade and Simcoe.</p>					
14.	CRAFTY DEVIL BREWING CO	BUDDY HOLLY	WEST COAST PALE ALE	4.5	
<p>An American pale ale with a mix of bright C hop aroma and flavour along with decent bitterness and a crisp dry finish with an unrivalled combo of citra and mosaic.</p>
